Welcome to the Niagara Regional Science and Engineering Fair 2025! Your child will be part of an event with many other students from across the region.

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW...

REGISTRATION NIGHT – Friday March 28, 2025 – 5:30pm to 8pm – Brock University – **Bob Davis Gym**

- Schools will be given a time block when students are asked to setup their projects.
- On arrival, parents and student(s) must go to the registration desk to sign in inside of the Bob Davis Gymnasium. (Please see parking information located at the bottom of page 2).
- At the registration desk you will receive a registration form and instructions on where your project location will be.
- Proceed to your designated project location and set up your project display. Review information recorded on your registration form and make any corrections if necessary.
- When your project setup is complete, please hand in your registration form at the safety check desk.
- Return to your project and please <u>remain</u> at your project until a safety check person comes to view your project setup. Your project <u>MUST</u> be signed off by the required "Rules and Regulations" representative or your project may not be accepted, and you may be disqualified.
- When your project has been signed off you may leave or stay for PUBLIC PREVIEW 7:30pm-8:30pm where you can practice before judging.

JUDGING DAY - Saturday March 29, 2025 - 9am to approximately 4:30pm - Bob Davis Gym

- 8:00 am to 8:45am Drop off your child(ren) at the Bob Davis Gym. There will be representatives from the NRSEF directing students at 8:45am to **South Block 204** for the Opening Ceremonies which will be starting at 9:00 am. **DO NOT BE LATE!!** (Note: Students will drop off all belongings at their project before the ceremonies. Juvenile students (grades 5 and 6) are asked to bring their lunches with them to the opening ceremonies.) **Parents are welcome to join us for the opening ceremonies.**
- Misbehaviours will be reported to the school principal and may result in expulsion from the NRSEF fair.
- **PARENTS** are kindly asked to wait outside the Bob Davis Gym until all the judging has been completed to pick up their children. Doors to the gym will open when all judging has finished. Students are asked to wait for their parents at their projects.


OPEN HOUSE – Saturday March 25, 2024 – 3:30pm to 4:30pm – Bob Davis Gymnasium

AWARDS NIGHT – Wednesday April 2, 2025 – 7:00pm to 9:00pm – St. Catharines Collegiate



The NRSEF is covering parking costs for our participants on Friday March 28 from 5:30 pm - 9 pm. To be eligible, you must still register your licence plate number with the HONK app. To claim FREE parking, please follow these instructions prior to, or on the day of registration:

- Go to the honk app (access via www.honkmobile.com)
- Create an account by following the prompts (this will require a phone number for verification)/Login to your account
- Once the account is created, go to "Search Zone ID"
- Enter Zone ID: **2451** (Lot **D**)
- Select the duration
- At checkout, select "Add Promo"
- Enter: NRSEF2025
- Enter your license plate
- Checkout by Select "Park for Free"

[This will work, even if you must park in the overflow lot 3]

- * The NRSEF is not liable for any parking fines or fess incurred if you park in a non-designated spot, or if you fail to register your vehicle. Owners are responsible for any additional parking costs if they arrive before 5:30 pm.
- ** Vehicle registration is only required Friday March 28. Parking is free for everyone on Saturday March 29, and requires no additional registration.
